Police Scotland Report

Acting Inspector David Happs reported on recent crime in the neighbourhood: one robbery on the walkway, cases of bogus workmen and shed break ins. □ Speeding on Strachan Road was not identified as a problem though the Edinburgh Council 20 mph zones should have impact. □ Police Scotland are hosting a public discussion on community council survey at Blackhall Library on 16 November between 10-12.

Agreed to liaise with The City of Edinburgh Council, North Office, and to request a professionally designed badger and tree logo for the Blackhall Village sign.

Meeting to discuss Edinburgh Council local development plan on 28 November. □ £30,000 has been allocated by Inverleith Neighbourhood Partnership to improve the junction at Davidson Mains/ Craigleith spur and walk/cycle pathway. Edinburgh Council to develop proposal.

Meeting at 9am on 19 November to discuss the junction with Edinburgh Council Transport Depart. at corner of Craigleith Cres. and Queensferry Rd.

CC likely to support retaining Blackhall Primary school at polling station as part of wider review if polling stations and districts.

CEC Councillors' Report

Cllrs Bagshaw, Barrie and Whyte updated on Strachan Road speeding problems reported, no identifiable section 75 progress though Ian to provide further info to Cllr bagshaw, likely continued support from Edinburgh Council of the No 13 bus route, and issues associated with class sizes and composite classes at Blackhall Primary.

Street lighting on Craigleith Road still inadequate and blisters not working. Cllr Barrie to look into issue and report back.

CC agreed to discuss Community Council business plan and support for Blackhall Athletic FC at the next meeting.
